Database of over 650,000 secondary sources to:

- **Local histories** – covering British and Irish history from 55 BCE to the present.
- **Global histories** – covering Britain and Ireland's relations overseas including former British colonies and Commonwealth countries.
- **Interdisciplinary and emerging areas within history.**

## Key features

- **Unique classification scheme** designed specifically for historians, with 8,000 thematic search categories.
- Searching by **historical period**.
- **Facilitates access to full-text.**
- Links to external websites, such as: **library catalogues**, **online reviews** (e.g. Reviews in History, H-Albion) and **researching historical figures** (e.g. Oxford Dictionary of Nation Biography, UK National Archives).
- **Email alerts.**
- **Metrics** (e.g. Author and journal profiles) available to research trends in British and Irish history.
