- Soon to be a gallery and exhibition space





### Aby Warburg (1866-1929)

- <u>"The world's weirdest library"</u>, The New Yorker (2015)
- Tracing the roots of the Renaissance in ancient civilisations; the history of myth, magic and ritual
- Bilderatlas Mnemosyne (1929) on the Warburg website
- Kulturwissenschaftliche Bibliothek
   Warburg founded in Hamburg in 1926
- The Institute was exiled to London in 1933

## Researching the history of magic at the Warburg Institute

- D.P. Walker, <u>Spiritual and Demonic Magic from Ficino to Campanella</u> (1958)
- Frances Yates, <u>Giordano Bruno and the Hermetic Tradition</u> (1964)
- Three editions of <u>Ghāyat al-Ḥakīm</u>, or <u>The Picatrix</u>, a key
   11th century Arabic text on magic and astrology (<u>Arabic</u> 1933;
   <u>German</u> 1962; <u>Latin</u> 1986)
- Charles Burnett on the transmission of knowledge through the medieval Islamic world, including magic, astrology and divination

### Renaissance magic

- Emerges from the study of philosophy, medicine, astrology
- Hidden knowledge: Neoplatonic philosophy, Kabbalah, Hermetic texts
- 15th century: <u>Marsilio Ficino</u>
   (1433-1499), <u>Giovanni Pico della</u>

   <u>Mirandola</u> (1463-1494)
- 16th century: <u>John Dee</u> (1527c.1608); <u>Heinrich Cornelius</u>
   <u>Agrippa</u> (1486-1535)

### Bibliotheca Bruniana online

- Giordano Bruno (1548-1600): philosopher, scientist and poet who wrote on magic and the art of memory
- Aby Warburg purchased a collection of c.350 books on Bruno
- Frances Yates, <u>Giordano Bruno and the Hermetic</u> <u>Tradition</u> (1964) and <u>The Art of Memory</u> (1966)
- Key primary and secondary texts digitised and available online






#### The Innes Collection

- Bequest from the estate of Michael Innes (1897-1980), received in 2012
- Over 600 early printed books and manuscripts
- Consolidates our already extensive holdings in the fields of Alchemy, Philosophy, Magic, Hermetism, Rosicrucianism, Kabbalah and related subjects
