Researching migration and refugee narratives in BBIH



BBIH is a database of over 660,000 references to:

- **Local histories** – covering British and Irish history from 55 BCE to the present.
- **Global histories** – covering Britain and Ireland's relations overseas including former British colonies and Commonwealth countries.
- **Interdisciplinary and emerging areas within history** – such as the histories of migration, race and ethnicity, gender, sexual identity, social class, dis/ability, mental health, environmental history and the history of emotions.

Researching migration and refugee narratives in BBIH

BBIH is update 3 times a year and includes bibliographic information on:

- **Books.**
- **Journal articles and reviews** from over 800 regularly searched journals.
- **Chapters from collective volumes**, including Festschriften and conference proceedings.
- **History PhD theses** submitted late 1990s-present.

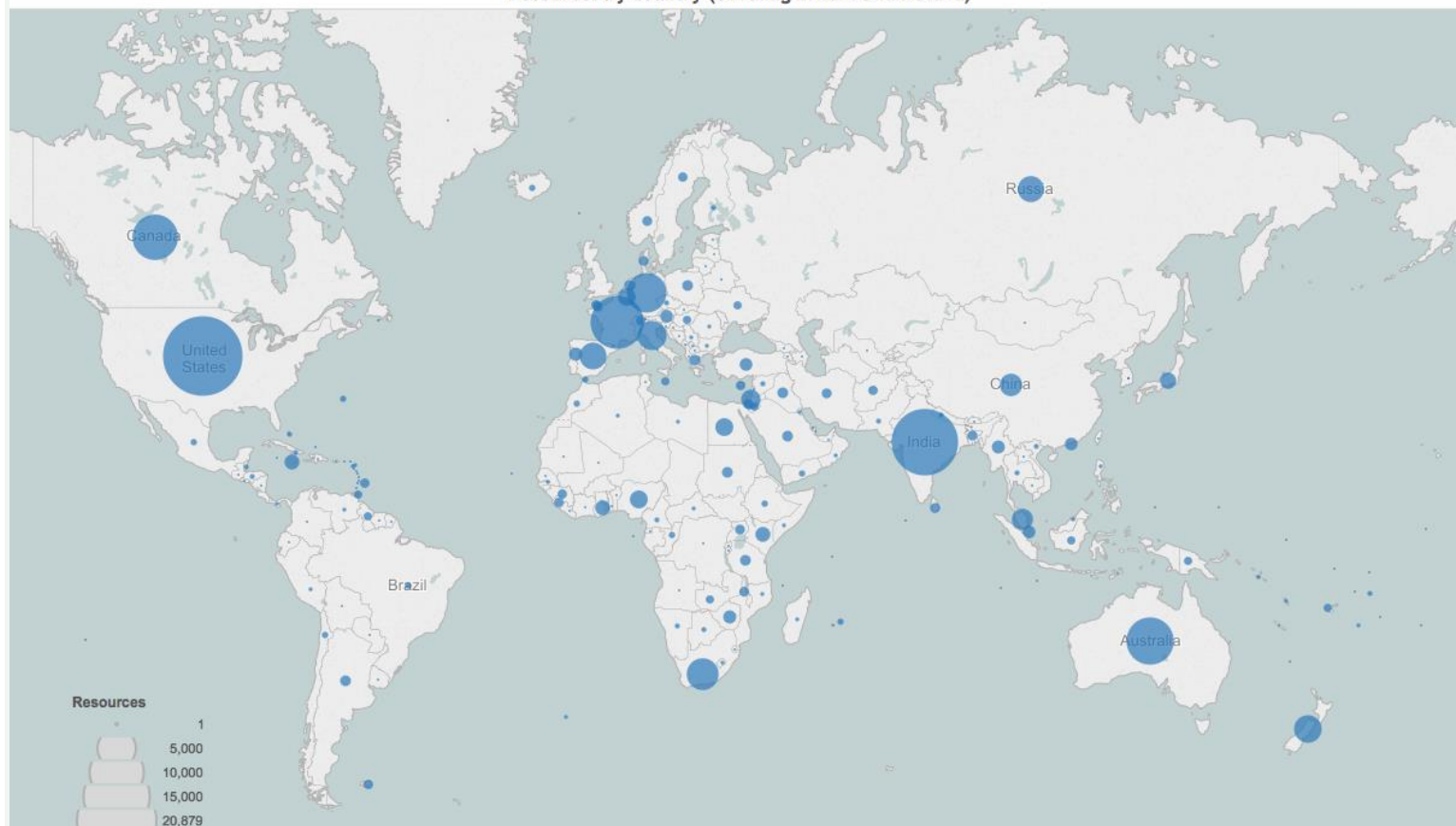
