Thomas Dekker, *The magnificent entertainment* (Imprinted at London by T. C. ..., 1604) [B.L.] 1604 [Magnificent]




John Tatham, London's tryumphs ... (London: printed by Thomas Mabb, 1661) [B.L.] 1661 [Londons Tryumphs]




Elkanah Settle, *The triumphs of London ...* (Printed by James Orme..., 1692) [B.L.] 1692 [Triumphs]






John Tatham, *London's tryumphs ...* (London: printed by Thomas Mabb, 1661), title page






