A. Yes, we've run CPD sessions for teachers using zoom, but I would suggest using a platform both organisations are happy with and one that matches the needs of the organisation - if you want to screen share most apps allow that. Same for chat features. But apps like zoom have breakout rooms which are useful if you want to separate the class into little groups and then get the group to feedback?
